NAVY HEALTH PROFESSIONS SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (HPSP) FOR MEDICAL PROGRAMS

The Health Professions Scholarship Program is designed to provide a financial incentive for students in designated health care professions to complete their medical or dental school degree requirements and obtain an Officer commission in the Navy's Medical Corps.

Scholarship Benefits:

- ✓ 3- and 4-year scholarships are available
- ✓ Receive a \$20,000 sign-on bonus
- ✓ 100% of medical school tuition paid
- ✓ 100% of academic fees paid (minus housing and meals)
- ✓ Full reimbursement for required books and equipment
- ✓ Receive a monthly stipend of \$2,700.00+ to spend as you like
- ✓ 45 days of paid Active Duty Training per year

Eligibility Requirements:

- ✓ Citizenship - Must be a U.S. citizen to apply for scholarship
- ✓ Age – must be able to fulfill all degree requirements by the age of 42
- ✓ Health – must meet the Navy's physical standards
 - Education – Must be enrolled or accepted into a medical school accredited by the American Medical Association (AMA), American Osteopathic Association (AOA)
 - Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.2
 - Must complete all academics/training as a full time student, attending all normal schools sessions (2 semesters or 3 quarters),
 - Must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher while completed academic requirements
- ✓ Minimum MCAT Score of 500

Service Obligation:

- ✓ HPSP recipients incur a minimum service obligation of:
 - 3-years active duty* minimum service obligation.

*Total service obligation is 8 years. Time not served on active duty will be served in the Inactive Ready Reserve (IRR).
